



ClipClub (Impulse Workshop) is a non-profit group that supports the development, implementation and promotion of short films. These are developed by young people or adults themselves. Supported by experts from the fields of acting and art, drawing on the resources of those interested. Each year, a project is supported in a foreign country (most notably: 2008 Tunisia, 2009 Ukraine and 2011 «[Youth Exchange](#)» in Luxembourg).

The resulting short films are presented during themed events as «discussion primers» (beginning in 1993 with [national campaigns for suicide prevention](#) up to «Video VS. Violence» at the [International Ecumenical Peace Convocation](#) in Jamaica 2011). A selection of short films will be presented at non-commercial festivals in Europe, North America, Oceania and the Russian-speaking countries, where the filmmakers get supportive feedback.

From 2011 young people and adults have been getting Micro Teachings using specially customized programs in the [SRG SSR](#) Federal Parliament TV Production Centre in Berne on the place of media in politics and how commercials work.
